This Society shall be known as The Michigan Academy of Science. Article II: Objects. The objects of this Academy shall be scientific research and the diffusion of knowledge concerning the various departments of science. Article III: Membership. The Academy shall be composed of Resident Members, Corresponding Members, Honorary Members, Patrons and Affiliated Societies. 1. Resident Members shall be persons who are interested in scientific work and resident in the State of Michigan. 2. Corresponding Members shall be persons interested in science, and not resident in the State of Michigan. 3. Honorary Members shall be persons distinguished for their attainments in science, and not resident in the State of Michigan, and shall not exceed twenty-five in number. 4. Patrons shall be persons who have bestowed important favors upon the Academy, as defined in Chapter I, Paragraph 4 of the By-Laws. 5. Resident Members alone shall be entitled to vote and...
