




Junior High School Mathematics, Vol. 3 (Classic Reprint)

Excerpt from Junior High School Mathematics, Vol. 3 While this book presents a thoroughly practical kind of mathematics, as do also Books I and II, it is the purpose of the book to make the treatment sufficiently formal to enable the student to appreciate more fully the nature of pure mathematics. It is only by so doing that the door of the science can be opened sufficiently to enable him to determine whether he should pursue the subject further. In Book I the work in arithmetic was extended, the subject of intuitive geometry was introduced, and the algebraic formula was used when needed; in Book II the work in arithmetic was continued, particularly as it refers to the problems of everyday life, and such algebra as is essential in various practical lines was set forth; and now Book III offers a fitting close to an introductory course in mathematics by extending the work in practical algebra, by showing the nature and some of the practical uses of trigonometry, and by introducing the student to the first steps...
