Alexander, of Delanson Schenectady Co., N.Y. For a period of nearly forty years Mr. Alexander had been keeping bees in a large way, producing honey by the carload. He was regarded during a large portion of that time as the most extensive bee-keeper in Northeastern New York; but it was not till later that he began to give to the public the secrets of his success. His first writings were so valuable, coming from so ripe an experience covering so many years, that, as editor of Gleanings, I finally induced him to furnish us a short series of articles. So much impressed was I with the value of his teachings in practical apiculture that I tendered him a sum far in excess of what I had ever offered any other new contributor, and with only one exception did I ever pay any writer...
